SITE MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

Check your site daily to prevent sediment runoff and avoid the cost of replacing materials or getting fined. Help protect our waterways for marine life and activities like swimming, boating, and fishing.



Correctly install, and regularly check, repair, or replace sediment controls such as silt socks or fencing. Remove any built-up sediment.



Stabilise entry/exit points with large gravel or rocks, and maintain a vegetative strip along the verge, to prevent sediment leaving the site.



Store building waste securely to keep it from being blown or washed away. Dispose of litter such as food wrappers in a covered bin or skip.



Secure stockpiles with a tarp or other barrier. Clean equipment in a designated area, away from drains, and dispose of hazardous materials safely.



Sweep up loose sediment and other building waste daily, especially before rain, and never hose them down the drain.



Display site information, including work hours, safety requirements, and emergency contact details, clearly during construction.
